**Advisory regarding renewal of International Driving Permit issued from India through the Consulate General of India, Ho Chi Minh City**

As per latest notification issued by the Ministry of Road, Transport and Highways (MoRT&H) vide no. G.S.R. 15(E) dated 07.01.2021, IDP holders can get their permit renewed, if these expire when they are abroad.

For the purpose, the applicant will have to apply with MoRT&H online at [www.parivahan.gov.in](http://www.parivahan.gov.in) and upload a receipt received from the Indian Embassy/Consulate, along with other supporting documents. The applicant willing to seek issuance of such receipt for the purpose, may apply with this Consulate with following documents :

- i) Application form for attestation (available on Consulate's website at : <https://www.cgihcmc.gov.in/page/application-form/>)
- ii) Original valid passport along with its copy
- iii) Original visa/TRC and its copy
- iv) Original existing International Driving Permit (IDP) and its copy
- v) valid domestic driving license issued by Government of India and its copy
- vi) Fee in cash : VND 276,000/-
- vii) Prior appointment for seeking consular service may please be booked online at : <https://www.cgihcmc.gov.in/page/appointment/>

On receipt of application through the portal [www.parivahan.gov.in](http://www.parivahan.gov.in) , the licensing authority will verify the documents, issue the IDP and shall courier it directly to the address of the applicant.

It may be noted that the role of the Consulate in this Consular Service is limited to the extent of facilitating submission of IDP renewal application form only. Any further correspondence pertaining to the subject, including status of the application would need to be verified directly from the concerned authority (MoRTH) in India.
