



Advisory for Indians living in the jurisdiction of CGI, Ho Chi Minh City

The Consulate General of India in Ho Chi Minh City requests the Indian nationals living under its jurisdiction to consider giving priority to their registration with the Consulate through the official website portal link (<https://www.cgihcmc.gov.in/register.php>) with all necessary information, which comes useful in rendering prompt assistance to Indian nationals in distress or in extraordinary circumstances, besides timely redressal of grievances. Such information is also useful for sharing important announcements.

The External Affairs Ministry has launched the Global Pravasi Rishta portal and app to connect with the over 30 million strong Indian diaspora across the world. It aims to create a three-way communication between the Ministry, Indian Missions and the diaspora. This portal is created to enable the registration of Indian diaspora members, i.e. NRIs, PIOs and the OCl's which will not only facilitate the Indian government to connect with the overseas Indian community but also facilitate NRIs, OCl's and PIOs community by connecting them to various new and existing government schemes benefiting them in various areas of interest. The Consulate General of India in Ho Chi Minh City requests Indian diaspora to register themselves on the link <https://pravasirishta.gov.in/home>.

Indian students are also requested to register themselves on the MADAD portal (<https://madad.gov.in>) with their full details like passport, course, university/institution, address, email ids. This portal will also assist during any crisis management and lend a helping hand to the students. It will also enable the students to reach the consular officers and services in time of emergencies.
